FAQ:

Who can participate in the musical?

All Golden students!! K-6, any class, any ability.

When and where do I register my child for the play?

Just go to the website www.goldenproductions.org, starting Nov. 16th.

Registration deadline is Dec. 6th. *Students who do not register by the deadline may not audition or participate.*

My kid wants to do the musical, but they don't know how to sing or dance, what do you think?

DO IT! At the end of the day, this is a *school musical*, with students of varied ages and abilities. Being part of a full theatrical production is exciting and fun. They learn about music, dance, acting, and stories. They bond with friends, new and old, and they are proud of the final product, no matter what role they played.

Did you hear? My child got a *lead role*!!!!

Congratulations!! I'm sure they'll do well! Don't forget that some students may have wanted lead roles that did not get them. Be proud, but be considerate of others, too.

Is there rehearsal today?

Rehearsals are Tuesdays and Thursdays starting Jan 7th, 2025

K-3 Ensemble on Tuesdays, 4th-6th Ensemble on Thursdays, leads vary

The last few rehearsals before tech week will be by cast instead of grade level.

Notices for rehearsals will be sent out on Parent Square.

Check the website **www.goldenproductions.org**, not every student rehearses every day.

Can I get tickets for my entire extended family?

To ensure that every child in the musical has family in the audience for at least one show, we roll out ticket sales in three phases. During our first round of ticket sales (Jan 22-29), each family will be limited to purchasing six tickets. During our second round of ticket sales (Feb 3-5), each family may purchase up to four tickets (10 total between the first two rounds). General ticket sales will open to everyone on Feb 9th and there will be no limit on ticket purchases. Please do not wait to purchase your tickets!

- Backstage "passes" for teachers
- Lead actor contracts
- Rehearsals will take place both in the MPR as well as outdoors
